

# Mullion In Bloom 2024

Mullion in Bloom is a group of volunteer garden enthusiasts who work together with Mullion Parish Council to create and maintain the floral displays throughout the village, as well as maintaining several green spaces within the village centre. We continue to have lots of lovely comments on our fabulous floral displays and our aim is just to make our community one to be proud of. A new chair & committee are now in place to continue & develop the work of this long standing group.

The duties we carry out and intentions for 2024 :

1. Maintaining The Mullion Garden throughout the year - community gardening events currently being held to rejuvenate this area in preparation for the Green Flag Award inspection in late spring.
2. Maintaining Tremenhee Car Park planting throughout the year.
3. Address weed issue at Atlantic Forge Carpark.
4. Maintaining rose bed & tend the grass area at Tregullas Junction.
5. Maintaining and sowing with wildflowers, this year at Tregullas boat.
6. Maintaining & planting the raised bed by Health Centre - changing to a herb & medicinal plant garden this year.
7. Maintain & plant troughs & planters around village Cenotaph with seasonal planting.
8. Planting of all ground level containers & towers in the village centre with seasonal planting.
9. Planting and maintaining all summer hanging baskets in village centre - some slight changes to the locations this year.
10. Planting and maintaining Ronnie's Boat with seasonal planting.
11. Cutting grass through the year & maintaining the rose bed next to the Fire Station.
12. Clearing the entrance & lane to the cemetery from Lender Lane.
13. Feeding the daffodils in Meaver Road & Cove Road annually.
14. Weeding and maintaining the Cornish hedge that runs from the Church entrance down to the Mullion Garden opposite the Old Inn.
15. Cutting the grass next to the footpath that runs down to Mullion Meadows.
16. Ongoing repair and maintenance to Tremenhee Carpark walls and maintenance of the car park drains.
17. Enter & host inspector for National Green Flag Awards for Mullion Village Garden.
18. Consulting for advice from horticultural professionals.
19. Developing relations with other village organisations with similar objectives.
20. Plans to create a further edition of Mullion Memories booklet.
21. Plans to raise awareness of the group within the community (via traditional and social media avenues) & to increase the different methods for public donations.
