4. Minutes

It was proposed by Councillor R Curnow, seconded by Councillor Mrs S Ireland and **RESOLVED** that the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 19 April 2011 be approved as a true record and be duly signed by the Chairman.

5. Declarations of Interest

6. Planning

Following consideration by Councillors of Planning Applications received from Cornwall Council, the following recommendations were made:

PA11/02909 – Mr P Evans – Trevelyan, Meaver Road – Continued use of land for the stationing of a chalet/caravan for domestic use without compliance with condition 2 attached to decision notice W2/87/0774/F dated 13 October 1987

This chalet/caravan has been in situ for over 20 years. No representations had been received against this application.

It was therefore proposed by Councillor R Willey, seconded by the Chairman and **RESOLVED** to support the planning application. One Councillor abstained from the vote.

It was suggested that a condition of the permission be that the chalet/caravan be tied to the property and that it remains in the same condition (i.e. as a chalet/caravan)

PA11/02849 – Mr R Mitchell – 18 Laflouder Fields – Extension and alterations to dwelling

The Applicant for this application was present at the meeting and agreed to answer any questions that members may have.

No representations had been received against this application which was located within the development boundary.

It was therefore proposed by the Chairman, seconded by Councillor R Curnow and unanimously RESOLVED to support the planning application.
