

**Mullion Village Community Interest Company Meeting held on Tuesday 18 June 2013 at 6.30pm at The Methodist Chapel, Churchtown, Mullion**

Councillor J Lang opened the meeting.

**1. Absence**

No apologies for absence were received. Councillor A Gilbert was also not in attendance.

**2. Minutes**

It was proposed by Councillor D German, seconded by Councillor R Willey and RESOLVED to approved the minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 19 March 2013. They were duly signed by the Councillor J Lang.

**3. Operating of the Public Conveniences in Mullion**

The Clerk advised the meeting that Cornwall Council had completed the renovation of the facilities, and in her opinion, had done a very good job.

The Parish Council had officially taken over the running of the toilets on Monday 29 April 2013 and had already received some very positive comments about the cleanliness of the facilities. Leases had been signed, and the outstanding amount of the Solicitors fees was due to be authorised for payment. Cornwall Council had agreed to pay £500 towards each lease. Due to the complications of a different land owner at Mullion Cove, the solicitor's fees had exceeded this amount by £258.00.

A blockage in the drains had already occurred in the Mullion Village toilets, and Aquarod had been called to deal with that problem.

It was also thought that a minor amount of vandalism was taking place, although this had now stopped.

Business rate relief from Cornwall Council had been applied for, although it had yet to be received.

**4. Finance and Accounts**

The grant money from Cornwall Council had been paid into the Parish Council bank account. Until business rate relief had been awarded, payments were being made from the Parish Council account.

**5. Other correspondence received**
